

COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR A CONCURRENT MAJOR PROGRAM

Students in the College of Agricultural Sciences seeking to obtain concurrent majors must request approval to do so by the departments and the dean of the college (Faculty Senate policy 60-10).

College of Agricultural Sciences students may not concurrently enroll in the general Agricultural Sciences (AGSC_BS) major and another College of Agricultural Sciences degree program.

Approval for all other concurrent major requests by College of Agricultural Science students will be made only when there are at least 18 credit hours of unique coursework for each major.
