

STRAWBERRIES-TO PLANT Crop Code: 3512

Standard Message:

Broadcast recommended fertilizer and disk in prior to planting. Add an additional 40 lb/acre actual nitrogen 6-8 weeks after planting. Always brush fertilizer off the leaves of plants--strawberry plants are very susceptible to fertilizer burn.

To convert fertilizer recommendations from lb/acre to lb/100 sq. ft., divide by 435.

If limestone is recommended, apply in the fall prior to planting. Do not apply more than 4000 lb/acre at one time. If more is required, apply 4000 lb/acre in the fall and the balance the following fall.
