Standard Message:

Apply the above lime and fertilizer at least the fall before establishing the planting. Since asparagus is a salt loving plant and high organic matter levels are beneficial in heavier soils, up to 3 tons of poultry manure or 25 tons of cattle manure per acre can also be applied the year before planting. Consider banding all manures and fertilizers where the row trenches will be dug.
