

### Ag Alumni Breakdown








### Alumni by State

#### **Executive Officers**

President, Immediate Past President, President Elect, and Financial Secretary

Eligibility – current Director, served at least one year, and cannot be an employee of Penn State. Term of Office – two years. May not serve in the same office for more than one two-year term. Nomination – The nominating committee shall prepare a slate of candidates. A majority vote of the Board of Directors is required.

#### **Elected Directors**

15 Directors

Three-year terms with one-third of the elected Directors having terms ending each year. Maximum of two terms.

Eligible for re-election after a three-year absence from the board.

The nominating committee prepares a slate of candidates for board approval, then a mail ballot is distributed to the Society membership for election.

#### **Associate Directors**

Appointed by each of the approved Affiliate Program Groups (APG) as their representative to the Board.

Have the same voting rights as the Directors.

Serve a term defined by the APG they represent.

#### **Ex-officio**

Non-voting

Immediate past president, regardless of term expiration as a director

The Dean of the College or designee

The president of the Ag Student Council or designee



#### **Alumni Society Trustee Scholarship**

 The Trustee Matching Scholarship maximizes the impact of private giving while directing funds to students as quickly as possible, meeting the urgent need for scholarship support. Students who have demonstrated financial need are beneficiaries of this scholarship endowment established in 2014.

#### **Scholarship Award**

 Scholarship funding is provided through the Ag Alumni Society Scholarship Endowment established in 1971. Scholarship recipients are chosen because of their academic standing, financial need, and recommendations from professors.

#### **Internship Award**

• The purpose of the Internship award, established in 1986, is to reward students who participate in an academically approved, educational internship program, show support of the internship program, and encourage alumni to make agriculture-related intern programs available to College of Agricultural Sciences students.

#### **Incoming First-Year Scholarship**

 Created in the spring of 2019, consideration for this scholarship is based on incoming first or second semester standing undergraduate students enrolled or planning to enroll full time in the College of Ag Sciences.


