General Information

ATM Machine: Located in the Ag Choice Building at the corner of Main and West 6th Streets.

Disability Services: Golf carts, courtesy of Lancaster Farming, will be available at the Ag Alumni Pavilion at West 11th and Main Street. They are made available on a first-come, first-served basis for two-hour increments to individuals with medical needs, and drivers must be 18 years or older. A limited supply of scooters will be available for rent from T & B Medical on West 9th Street.

Information Booth: Located at Main Street and across from West 10th Street. Lost-and-found items are kept at the Information Booth. Lost children and adults should contact security personnel on the grounds or report to the Information Booth.

Medical Services: A first aid station is located in the headquarters (white farmhouse) at Main and West 10th Streets. Emergency medical technicians and an ambulance are on site during show hours. Access emergency assistance by dialing 911 or contact security personnel on site.

Merchandise Sales: Ag Progress Days T-shirts and Penn State Dairymen's Club Milk Bottles are for sale in the College Exhibit Building at West 10th and Main Streets. Proceeds go to the Penn State College of Ag Sciences Undergraduate Education Services. The Penn State Dairymen's Club sells milk bottles as a fundraiser for scholarships.

Pets: University policy prohibits pets in buildings or tents and should be leashed and under control by their owners if on the show grounds. Owners are required to clean up after their pets.

Portable toilets and hand-washing stations: Facilities are located throughout the grounds (see map). In addition, handicap restroom facilities and infant changing tables are also available in the Special Events Building and Pasto Museum.

Recycling: Please help support Penn State's recycling efforts. Use the blue recycling containers throughout the grounds. These containers are for plastic bottles and mixed paper.

Relocations: Maple Products Food Booth has relocated to Main and West 8th. Curly fries are now on Demo Alley. PSU Water Extension Team and Ag and Environmental Center have relocated to the College Exhibit Building as featured exhibits.

Mapping and Booth Label Reference Guide

Exhibitors have specific booth numbers, assigning them to their location to connect with our new interactive map. Click the exhibitor booth from the online map to search for more information about the company. Booth labels identify the building, tent, or area with the first one or two letters coded for the name of a location (xx), see Locations Abbreviation Key (at the right).

Indoor exhibits located in the building or tent are numbered from the entrance, beginning with the hundred number indicating rows 1 thru 5, with the higher numbered booth typically on the southern side of the exhibit tent or building.

Outdoor exhibit booth labels use the first letter or letters to identify if they are located East (E) or West (W) of Main St. or are located on Main St. (M). In addition, outdoor exhibit booth labels use the border streets of Demo Alley (DA) and Harrington Lane (H) as noted on the map. The first one or two numbers identify the street on which they are located, streets 1 thru 13. Typically the exhibitor booth space numbers on the north side of street are even and those on the south side are odd numbers.





Tours

Hands-on tours highlight various aspects of agriculture. Get a free ticket and board the bus at the tour registration and loading area at the top of Main Street. There are a limited number of tickets available per tour, so stop by early to reserve your seat. *Note: Walking and/or standing is involved once the bus arrives at the tour destination.*

American Chestnut Foundation Plantings Tour (1.25 hours)	See American chestnut breeding orchards. Learn about the history and demise of the American chestnut tree, how to plant and maintain chestnut trees, and The American Chestnut Foundation's citizen scientists and programs working to restore the species. Bus leaves Tuesday at 3:30 p.m., Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and Thursday at 10:00 a.m. Note: Walking/standing involved. No restrooms available.
NEW! Industrial Hemp Research (1.5 hour)	This tour will showcase Penn State's first industrial hemp project in more than 60 years. We will discuss some of the crop management issues to consider in hemp production and see some trials that evaluate several varieties of hemp being grown for seed. Participants will also be able to evaluate some hemp produced with no-tillage and also look at the impacts of seeding rates, planting dates and fertilizer rates on commercial hemp production. We will also get an update on potential markets for the crop. Bus leaves daily at 2:00 p.m. <i>Note: Walking/standing involved. No restrooms available.</i>
High Tunnel Tour (2 hours)	High tunnels are inexpensive structures used for extending the growing season and improving yields and quality of vegetables, berries, and cut flowers. At Penn State's High Tunnel Research and Extension Facility, strawberries and raspberries are being grown in containers in 15 tunnels with five different types of plastics to better manage plant growth, temperatures, and pests. To learn how to better manage heat load, four additional tunnels are equipped with various types of solar-powered automated venting options including a ridge-vent, roll-up roof, roll-down sides, and roll-up sides. Work being conducted will be explained and effects of the plastics on yields and microenvironment will be discussed. Bus leaves daily at 10:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. <i>Note: Walking/standing involved. No restrooms available.</i>
NEW! Adaptive Grazing Soil Health (1.5 hours)	Improving your farm's soil health is key in the overall success of your operation; this tour will focus on adaptive grazing management, where tall grass or high stock density grazing can drastically transform mediocre fields into highly productive pastures that can extend the grazing season well into winter. We'll discuss and detail the benefits to frequent animal moves, consideration for fencing and watering as well as the forage benefits to tall grass grazing. In the second half of the tour we'll take about diverse cover crop mixes for use in cropping or grazing systems and how to graze mixes for additional forage. Tour will feature hands-on activities with paddock rotation and fencing/watering system components as well as evaluation of cover crop mixes to get a better look at rooting structure and soil improvement benefits. Bus leaves daily at 10:30 a.m., 12:30 p.m., with additional tours Tuesday and Wednesday at 2:30 p.m. Note: Walking/standing involved. No restrooms available.
Short Rotation Woody Crops for Biomass (1 hour)	What are short rotation woody crops? How do they contribute to biomass feedstock? Why are they being promoted for marginal planting sites? What type of species should you grow and who will buy it? Tour includes a visit to a demonstration plot with fast- growing willow and poplar trees. Learn how to grow, harvest, and produce this crop as an alternative income opportunity that helps provide sustainable energy supplies. Bus leaves daily at 11:00 p.m. <i>Note: Walking/standing involved. No restrooms available.</i>
NEW! Multifunctional Stream Buffers and Native Grass Field Tour (1 hour)	This tour focuses on the importance of planting and maintaining trees and shrubs to create a multifunctional stream buffer that will improve water quality, wildlife habitat, livestock health, property value, and provide edible or medicinal plants. You will learn about the 3 P's of tree establishment—Preparation, Planting, and Protection—to increase tree survival and reduce competition from invasive weeds. See demonstration livestock practices such as fencing and stream crossings and learn about financial assistance programs available. See and learn how to plant native grass fields to increase sustainability and help declining pollinators and beneficial insects. Bus leaves daily at 11:30 p.m. <i>Note: Walking/standing involved. No restrooms available.</i>
Woodlot Management Tour: Decisions and Actions (1.5 hours)	Woodlot management takes time, commitment, and planning. It seems that every decision and activity raises new challenges and opportunities. Come explore the woodlot and gain valuable insights into how management decisions affect future values. The Penn State Demonstration Woodlot is 150 acres in size. It is managed for multiple objectives including: timber production, wildlife habitat, water quality, recreational activities and of course, research and demonstration for education. Forestry and wildlife professionals lead the tours and will be on hand to answer your questions help you find resources to effectively steward Pennsylvania's woodlands.
