The Student Scholarships and Awards Committee for 2010-2011 was Diane McLaughlin-Chair, Bill Lamont, and Phil Clauer. For the 2010-2011 academic year, the committee awarded a total of 380 active scholarships to 678 students. The students received a college and/or department scholarship for a total amount of scholarships being awarded of \$1,802,713 for the 2010-2011 academic year. The Student Scholarships and Awards Committee for 2011-2012 will be Bill Lamont- Chair, Phil Clauer, and James Howell who will select the awardees for 2011-2012 academic year. The committee wishes to thank Denise Connelly and Kathie Alterio for all their organization and insights that made our job so much easier.

On Tuesday, 29 March 2011 the Student Scholarships and Awards Committee of Bill Lamont, Phil Clauer and James Howell met with Randi Congleton, Director, Multicultural Programs, College of Agricultural Sciences to select talented high school students for the prestigious Bunton/Waller and Enrollment Incentive awards. The committee meets separately for these awards, as each college is required to notify financial aid of our decision no later than April 2, 2011, which is before the traditional Agricultural Sciences scholarship process. The scholarship committee chose two students (Morgan Brown and Samantha Rosado) to receive the Bunton/ Waller Fellowship and an alternate in the event that a student says no. We also chose students to receive the Enrollment Incentive Award which is a scholarship valued at up to the cost of in state tuition and the Bunton /Waller Scholarship (\$7,500 per year).
