

Total Student Activity funds available for 2010/11 FY was \$28,000 (This is a 27.2% increase from FY 09/10 - \$22,000).

The \$28,000 was split (60/40) between Competitive and Non-Competitive events.

For Competitive Events, a total of \$16,800 was available from the college. The total allocation was split proportionately to reflect historical levels of requests. Thus, \$5,040 was distributed in fall and \$11,760 in spring. The funding requests for competitive events for Fall 2010 totaled over \$11,200 and Spring 2011 totaled over \$41,000.

For Non-Competitive Events, a total of \$11,200 was available from the college. The total allocation was split proportionately to reflect historical levels of requests. Thus, \$2,240 was distributed in fall and \$8,960 in spring. The funding requests for non-competitive events Fall 2010 totaled over \$6,400 and Spring 2011 totaled over \$49,000.

Higher priority (ranked) activities received a larger share of their requests, whereas lower priority (ranked) proposals received a lesser share of the requests.
