## 2024 Penn State Flower Trial Submission Procedures:

- Cultivars in containers can be placed in full sun or full shade for a fee of \$75. The trial requests 25 rooted plugs (or liners) per entry in this category. The container trial runs for a single season until September.
- If you desire to have an entry grown in <u>both</u> sun and shade containers (suggested for impatiens, begonias, and coleus) the fee is \$100 per cultivar, to cover the cost of the second planting. The trial requests 50 rooted cuttings for each entry in the SUN & SHADE category.
- Perennials that you wish to trial for hardiness can be entered into our in-ground overwintering program. The entry fee of \$125 covers the trial costs for the full <u>3-year term</u>. For each in-ground entry the trial requests 16 rooted cuttings. Bed space is limited and materials will be accepted on a first-come basis.
- Displays at collaborative, in-ground satellite sites require an additional 18 plugs. We currently display a collection of entries at Hershey Gardens, Ag Progress Days, and North Park Gardens. Qualifying plants are chosen at the Director's discretion.
- Plug material only. If you wish to trial seed or unrooted cuttings, please arrange to have them grown into plugs before shipping to PSU. Contact us if you have questions or need help making these arrangements.
- Entry forms are due by February 16, 2024. If you need more time, contact us. Please be certain to label each cultivar on your entry list to include:
  - Entry Type: Container or In-ground, three-year overwintering trial
  - Condition: Sun, Shade, or Sun and Shade
  - Entry Name to include correct Registered ® or Trademark™ symbols
  - Identify any items you wish as "NEW" on trial labels.
  - Email: Current Logo and Web Address to des346@psu.edu for display
- Include a Packing List with each shipment.
