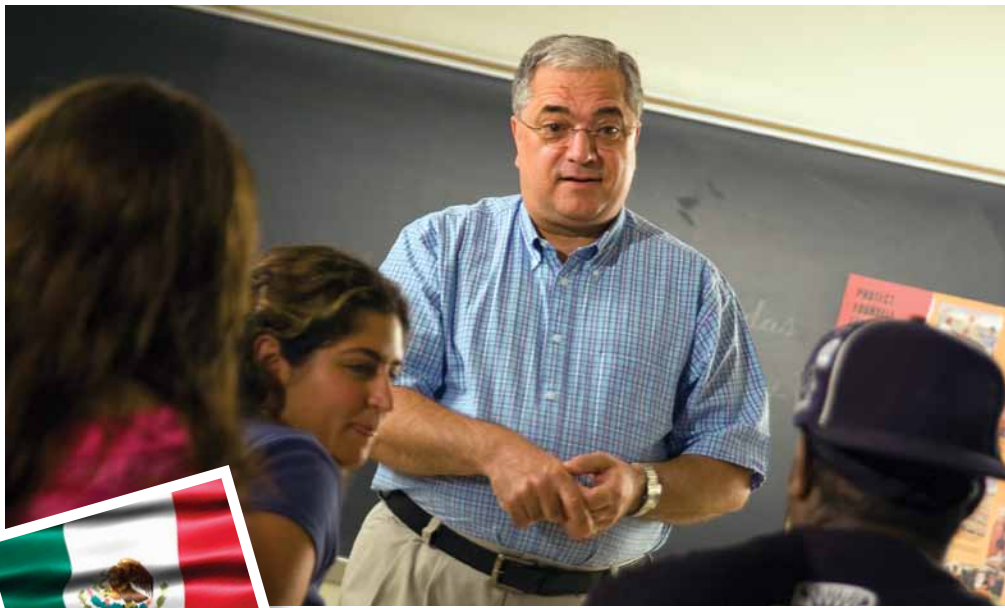

Spanish for the Ag Science Industry

“Think Outside the Barn” and plan ahead. Register for SPAN 105 in the fall or spring semester. Then, in the fall semester, sign up for SPAN 106. The following spring, sign up for SPAN 197A and complete the three-course program with the SPAN 197A immersion experience. Last year’s class completed **a three-week immersion experience in Mexico**, leaving in mid-May and returning home with enough time to start summer internships or jobs.



- **SPAN 105:** First course of the three-course sequence; primarily for students who have had little to no prior experience studying Spanish.
- **SPAN 106:** Prerequisite: SPAN 105 or placement exam administered by course instructor.
- **SPAN 197A:** Prerequisites: SPAN 105 and/or SPAN 106. This course includes an immersion experience at the end of spring semester, during which students live with Mexican families while studying and experiencing the language, culture, and agricultural industries of Mexico.
