Eligible scholarship applicants must be enrolled in an agricultural degree program in a college or trade school; be between the ages of 17 and 26; and secure transportation to and from the event.

Scholarship Selection:

Scholarships will be awarded on the following criteria and at the discretion of PennAg Industries Association staff.

- Date application is received.
- Distribution of applicants from different geographic regions of the state, institutions represented and overall demand for scholarships.
- Applicant's expressed interest in the program and future plans for involvement in the agriculture industry.
