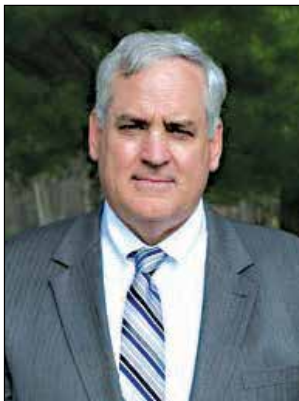


Welcome to Timber 2023

The Voice of the Forest Products Industry in Pennsylvania

The Pennsylvania Forest Products Association (PFPA) is proud to co-host Timber 2023.

The PFPA counts over 280 companies among its members, representing all segments of forest products production and manufacturing, as well as companies providing equipment and services to the industry.

It is the mission of PFPA to promote the common interests of the forest products industry within Pennsylvania by:

- Creating a regulatory environment in Pennsylvania that enhances the profitability of the entire forest products industry;
- Creating among the general public an increased knowledge of, and appreciation for, the value of the forest products industry in Pennsylvania, and the contributions the industry makes to forest sustainability; and
- Increasing the amount of information available to the industry regarding legislative and regulatory issues, technical matters, and activities within the industry.

Track Record of Advocacy Success

PFPA is the recognized voice in Pennsylvania state and local government affairs for all sectors of the forest products supply chain. We work daily on legislative and regulatory issues that affect your business. PFPA represents the forest products industry on more than a dozen formal state agency advisory committees, helping to guide these agencies on issues such as hardwood promotion, forest health and management, research, and truck safety.

Since our founding, PFPA has consistently focused on policies that support the competitiveness of Pennsylvania's forest products supply chain. In 2017, PFPA-supported legislation took effect that extended a Sales and Use Tax exemption to include equipment and material used in commercial timber operations. This update to our tax code has made it much easier for members of our industry to invest in the equipment and materials needed to operate safely and competitively.

PFPA has also successfully advocated for Letters of Local Determination to provide relief from excessive state road posting and bonding costs for timber and other "at risk" industries. PFPA continues to advocate for policies that improve the reliability of our transportation infrastructure by efficiently applying available resources to roadway maintenance and improvement.

Some of the Key Issues that PFPA is currently working on include:

- PFPA is working with the public and private sectors to address worker's compensation rates and availability.
- PFPA supports appropriate changes to Bureau of Forestry policy to allow for greater use of mechanized harvesting

equipment.

- PFPA is working with the DCNR and the Department of Agriculture to address invasive pest issues.
- PFPA continues to work against proposals that would harm its members with additional regulation or taxation.
- PFPA is a founding member of the Real American Hardwood Coalition, a nationwide initiative providing education and outreach to consumers regarding the advantages of naturally authentic hardwood products.
- PFPA is working in concert with national level partners to ensure proper credit is given for the forest products industry's role in increasing the capacity for storage and the rate of capture of carbon from our atmosphere.

We are also a valuable resource to assist our members to successfully navigate state and local regulation.

Educating the Public

PFPA has been a leader in educating the public about the importance of sustainable forestry and the role that our companies play in creating jobs and improving the environment across our state.

PFPA helped to create the first PA WoodMobile in 2002 and the redesigned WoodMobile in 2015. This mobile educational display continues to shine. In 2020, the WoodMobile program adapted to the pandemic by implementing a new format for virtual outreach. In 2023, the WoodMobile continues to offer virtual content while implementing its busiest year ever of traditional hands-on programs that have become the model for similar programs in other states. Since 2002, approximately 2 million participants have visited the PA WoodMobile, including more than 220,000 students and teachers.

Informing Industry

PFPA keeps its members and others in the industry updated on happenings in Harrisburg and across the state through its weekly newsletter, The Ticker, and publication of the Pennsylvania Marketing Bulletin. It provides information and education through this biennial Timber Show, Annual Meeting, annual Forest Products Executive Development Workshop, Regional Meetings, special seminars, webinars and workshops. It also raises funds through the Log and Load for Kids to support Children's Miracle Network Hospitals in Pennsylvania.

PFPA also is the administrative host of the Pennsylvania Sustainable Forestry Initiative®. The PA SFI® Implementation Committee in Pennsylvania provides logger training, landowner outreach and promotes the use of sustainable wood and paper products.

The college also offers three two-year programs, including Forest Technology and Wildlife Technology. About 80 percent of the college's undergraduates come from non-agricultural backgrounds. The college has one of Penn State's largest scholarship programs, awarding \$2.5 million annually.



Penn State Extension

Penn State Extension is a statewide network that links the resources of the college and university to individuals, families, businesses, and communities in each of Pennsylvania's 67 counties. Extension reaches more than 750,000 households annually with research-based information and educational programs in agriculture; natural resources and environmental management; 4-H/youth development; community and economic development; family and consumer sciences; leader-

ship and volunteer development; and nutrition, diet, and health.

Research

The college annually invests more than \$100 million in research involving faculty, staff, and undergraduate and graduate students. Scientists conduct basic and applied research in subject areas ranging from biotechnology and genetics to forest regeneration and animal health. The college maintains 13,800 acres of research forest and farmland, including the Russell E. Larson Agricultural Research Center at Rock Springs and the Experimental Forest at Stone Valley. The college's research addresses critical issues of agrosecurity, business profitability, environmental sustainability, youth development, food safety, rural community vitality, bioenergy and bio-based products, and natural resource conservation.
